(*Semi-Private room monthly rate*)  
Veteran \$3,394  
Non-Veteran \$5,604
- ✓ Special Care Alzheimer's & related dementia  
(*Semi-Private room monthly rate*)  
Veteran \$3,820  
Non-Veteran \$7,295
- ✓ Possible VA funds awarded to cover the cost of care based on service-connected disability benefits.
- ✓ Medicare Part A and Part B therapy services offered.

## ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for admission veterans must have active federal service with discharge under conditions other than dishonorable. On a space available basis, the Home may provide care to eligible spouses, surviving spouses or Gold Star parents.

The Kansas Veterans' Home is proud to serve American veterans and their spouses regardless of race, color, national origin, disability, gender, including sexual orientation or gender identity, religion or age in admission, treatment or participation in its programs, services and activities.



## HISTORY

The Kansas Veterans' Home, established in 2000 on the former grounds of the Winfield State Hospital and Training Center is a fully renovated facility now home to approximately 110 residents.

## THE COMMUNITY

Nestled in the scenic Flint Hills just 35 miles southeast of Wichita, Winfield, Kansas is a welcoming town of 12,000 that blends small-town charm with a spirited sense of innovation and community.

Highlights include:
